## GEAR REQUIREMENTS & PREPARATION

### Attire & Personal Gear

You will spend extended periods **outdoors in dynamic environmental conditions**, including **high winds, temperature fluctuations, rain, dust, and mud**. Be prepared for extreme weather shifts.

### Recommended Equipment:

- Tactical or hiking boots (No open-toe footwear)
- Weather-appropriate outerwear (rain gear, cold-weather layers)
- Gloves (both shooting gloves and weather-resistant gloves recommended)
- Hat (for sun/weather protection)
- Water bottle
- Day pack for carrying gear

### Firearms & Ammunition

Your precision rifle setup must meet **minimum accuracy requirements** for long-range applications. **Unqualified rifles or optics will impact your training effectiveness**. Ensure your rifle is properly **cleaned** before arrival.

### Minimum Requirements:

- **Rifle:** Capable of **1 MOA accuracy out to 1000 meters**
- **Ammunition:** 200 rounds of **match-grade ammo** (Must be identical in type & weight) and of the same LOT#.
  - **Reloaders:** Consistency is critical. Ensure uniformity in **projectile, casing, powder, and primer and each component is of the same LOT#**.
- **Optics:** **Tactical scope** with adjustable turrets (MOA/MIL-based systems only)
- **Rifle Accessories:**
  - Anti-cant device (**Mandatory**)
  - Shooting mat – Available for loan
  - Spotting scope – Available for loan
  - Shooting bag – Available for loan
- **Other Gear:**
  - Small calculator (smartphone calculators are acceptable)

- Writing materials (notebook, pens, pencils)
- Full rifle cleaning kit & maintenance tools (**Mandatory**)

Failure to meet these equipment standards may limit your training progression. **If you need assistance acquiring gear, contact us immediately.**

## SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Safety is **our highest priority**. Our instructors maintain complete range control at all times, and **absolute adherence to commands is mandatory**.

- **Unsafe actions will result in immediate course dismissal.**
- If you have **concerns about any drill or feel unsafe**, notify an RFMA instructor immediately.
- **Upon arrival, keep all firearms, ammunition, and gear secured in your vehicle** until instructed to retrieve them for inspection.
- All attending students will receive a range safety brief prior to the start of training.

## MEALS & NUTRITION

**Preparation Tips:**

- **Bring high-energy, nutritious meals** to sustain performance over long days.
- **Water is critical.** The training environment is **extremely dry**—bring ample hydration supplies.

- Strict Adherence to Safety (Safety Brief given on arrival on Day 1)
- Any shooter violating safety protocols will receive one warning.
- Repeated violations or reckless behavior will result in immediate removal from training.
- Alcohol & Substance Policy
  - Absolutely no alcohol or drugs are allowed before or during training.
  - Participants under the influence will be removed immediately.

## ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

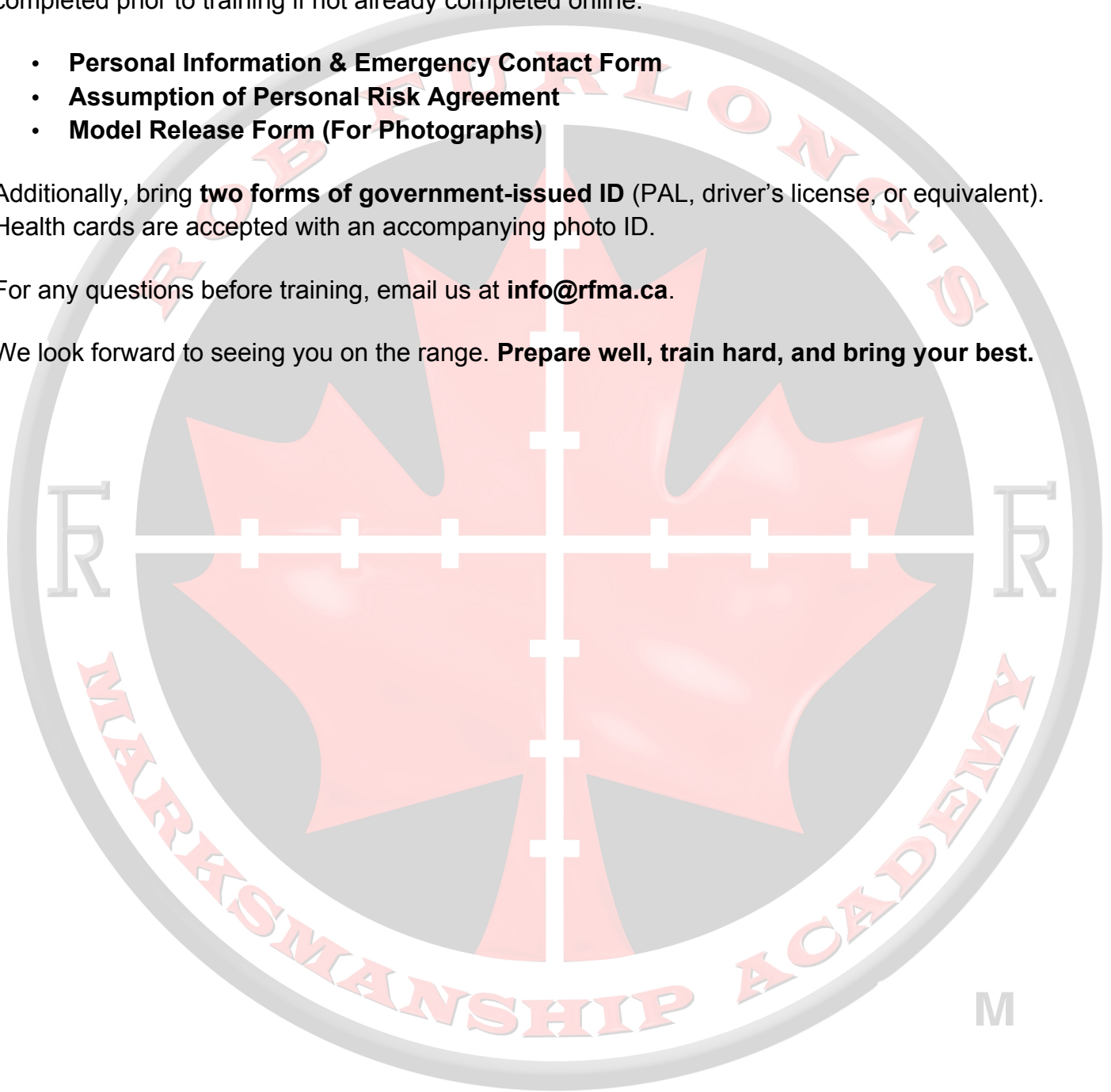
On **day 1 (Meet & Greet) 0800hrs at RFMA Training Facility**, the following forms must be completed prior to training if not already completed online.
